Rules to Receive CE Credit

In-person attendance:

The ARRT requires that all registrants seeking Category A+/A credit must be present and attentive for 50 minutes of every scheduled hour of a live CE activity. If you arrive late, leave early, or slip out of the meeting room for a break, that time is deducted from your attendance. Registrants arriving more than 10 minutes late or leaving more than 10 minutes early will not receive CE credit.

Your QR code on your name badge must be scanned at the beginning and end of each presentation, even if you do not leave the room between presentations. Each presentation has its own attendance log.

Be sure to have your certificate stamped before leaving the room. Certificates will not be stamped for earlier presentations after the next presentation has begun. Your certificate is proof of attendance and should be uploaded to the ASRT (if you are an ASRT member) or ARRT for CE credit. Lost certificates cannot be replaced.

Please do not use any electronic devices unless asked to by the speaker. Please silence all electronic devices during presentations.

Remote (Zoom) attendance:

Remote attendance is designed for technologists. While the Friday morning student activities will be broadcast, no remote student competition for the Student Bee, iLEAD presentations, or the RAD T-Shirt contest will be allowed.

TXSRT business sessions will be broadcast via Zoom. However, to be counted as part of the quorum, participate in the discussions, and vote, TXSRT members must attend in person. No remote or proxy votes will be accepted.

All CE presentations offered in the Comanche Suites will be broadcast via Zoom and available for CE credit. These presentations are intended for technologists. CE presentations in Bolin 100 intended for students are also available for CE credit but only for registrants attending in person.

The ARRT requires that all registrants seeking Category A+/A credit must be present and attentive for 50 minutes of every scheduled hour of a live CE activity. If you log into the Zoom session late or leave early, that time is deducted from your attendance. Registrants logging in more than 10 minutes late or logging out more than 10 minutes early will not receive CE credit.

All registrants must complete an online survey to receive CE credit. The link to the survey will be posted in the chat at the end of each presentation and will be open for 15 minutes. After the survey closes, no further entries will be accepted. Your CE certificate you will receive is created from the survey respondent lists and verified with the Zoom attendance logs. You will be emailed their CE certificates within four weeks of the end of the conference.
